



HALIBURTON HOCKEY HAVEN SPORTS CAMP RELEASE/REGISTRATION AND INFORMATION FORMS

AUTHORIZATION, ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

In consideration of Haliburton Hockey Haven Inc. (“HHH”) providing a camp program (the “Camp”) and in which the undersigned’s child or children (collectively, the “Camper”) is enrolled and allowing the Camper to use any part of the premises, facilities or equipment operated by HHH at the property located at 2797 Kashagawigamog Lake Road, Haliburton, Ontario (the “Property”) and owned by the Operator’s affiliate (the “Owner”) or at A.J. LaRue Arena in Haliburton (the “Rink” and collectively with the Property, the “Facilities”) and other good and valuable consideration, the undersigned, on behalf of itself, the Camper and any other parent or legal guardian of the Camper or any successors-in-interest (the “Undersigned”), agrees in favour of HHH as follows:

(a) Medical Treatment: authorizes HHH or an individual employed or associated with HHH in the event of an emergency, to use reasonable discretion, on behalf of the Undersigned, the Camper or associated spectators participating in or attendance at HHH's Camp, in rendering first aid and/or arranging for emergency medical care (including calling an ambulance or hospitalization), at the expense of the Undersigned;

(b) Risks: acknowledges that (i) the undersigned is enrolling in the Camp willingly, (ii) the Camper is participating voluntarily in the Camp, (iii) there are risks associated with participation in activities associated with the Camp, (iv) accepts all such risks and agrees to be responsible for any injury or other loss which the Undersigned or the Camper might receive or suffer while participating in Camp activities and programs or being present at the Facilities;

(c) Release and Indemnity: TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THE UNDERSIGNED RELEASES AND HOLDS HARMLESS (I) THE OPERATOR AND THE OWNER, THEIR SHAREHOLDERS, AFFILIATES AND EACH OF SUCH ENTITIES' RESPECTIVE DIRECTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, MEMBERS, OFFICERS, OWNERS, EMPLOYEES, COUNSELLORS, VOLUNTEERS, AGENTS AND ASSIGNS, AND (II) ANY OTHER PARTICIPANTS OR ATTENDEES (COLLECTIVELY, THE "RELEASEES") FROM ANY AND ALL KNOWN AND UNKNOWN LIABILITIES, OBLIGATIONS, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, COSTS, EXPENSES, LOSSES OR DAMAGES WHATSOEVER (“CLAIMS”) THAT THE UNDERSIGNED, THE CAMPER, OR ANY SUCCESSORS-IN-INTEREST OR ANYONE CLAIMING UNDER OR THROUGH THEM, MAY HERINAFTER HAVE FOR ALL INJURIES, ILLNESSES, DEATH, MEDICAL TREATMENT, DAMAGES, COST OR EXPENSES, HOWSOEVER CAUSED, SUSTAINED OR INCURRED OR ARISING FROM OR RELATED TO PARTICIPATING IN OR ATTENDEANCE AT THE CAMP OR ANY OF THE FACILITIES BY THE CAMPER, THE UNDERSIGNED OR ANY OTHER PERSON OR SUSTAINED TO ANY OF THE UNDERSIGNED OR THE CAMPER’S PROPERTY OR THE PROPERTY OF ANY OTHER PARTICIPANTS AS A RESULT OF THE CAMPER’S PRESENCE AT THE FACILITY OR PARTICIPATION IN ANY ACTIVITY OR OTHERWISE ARISING IN ANY WAY FROM THE CAMPER’S PRESENCE AT THE PROPERTY.

(d) Refunds/Credits/Termination: acknowledges that there will be no make-up Camp dates for any missed days or period due to illness or other personal reasons of Camper and acknowledges that a refund or credit will only be available should a Camper withdraw (by written notice) at least 120 days before the Camp week in which the Camper is enrolled, subject to an administrative fee of \$10.00 for each registered



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Camp day. No refunds/credits will be available if less than 120 days' prior written notice is provided for a cancelled week due to illness or other personal reasons. The Directors of the Camp reserve the right to terminate the registration of any Camper if, in their sole discretion, the Directors determine such termination to be in the best interest of the Camper or the Camp;

(e) Program Cancellation: acknowledges that while HHH tries to balance providing sufficient advanced notice of cancellation and not cancelling any Camp week prematurely, in the unlikely event that an insufficient number of students/campers have registered for a particular camp week, HHH reserves the right to cancel such program. If camp weeks have to be cancelled for such reasons and no convenient alternative can be arranged, payment (if any) already made will be fully refunded;

(f) Policies and Information: acknowledges that the undersigned has read and understood all policies and information contained in this form and related materials distributed with this form and accepts the terms and conditions set out herein and therein;

(g) Publicity: acknowledges that photographers and videographers take pictures and videos on behalf of HHH of campers for use in various forms of advertising, websites, publications and social media and gives consent to HHH taking any of such photographs and video images of the Camper and the use by HHH of the Camper's likeness for publicity purposes in any form of media including social media without being captioned with the Camper's name;

(h) Electronics Free Policy: acknowledges that HHH has and will enforce a STRICT NO CELL PHONE/DEVICE/ELECTRONICS policy (including laptops, tablets, other computers, electronic games and other devices) for the enjoyment of Camp by all campers and that if Camper is found with or using them, they will be required to be checked with HHH Camp Staff for the duration of their stay; and

(i) **RISK OF COVID-19/CORONAVIRUS:** The Undersigned represents and warrants as follows:

- The Camper is not experiencing any symptom of illness such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever (38.0°C or 100.4°F), chills, headache, sore throat or new loss of taste or smell
- The Camper has not travelled to the United States or internationally within the last 14 days
- The Camper has not been exposed to someone with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19/Coronavirus as far as the Undersigned is aware
- The Camper has not been diagnosed with COVID-19/Coronavirus in the last 14 days

By signing this Authorization, Acknowledgement and Release, the Undersigned acknowledges that it is aware of the national emergency caused by the COVID-19/Coronavirus pandemic, the contagious and evolving nature of health crisis caused by COVID 19/ Coronavirus ("Coronavirus"), including the significant danger of community spread and risks posed to the health of those who contract Coronavirus, including the risk of serious illness or death. The Undersigned acknowledges that HHH and the Owner can not guarantee that the Camper will not contract Coronavirus while at the Facility or on the Property and that the risks of contracting Coronavirus from attendance at the Property and/or participating in any activity at the Facility are significant, including the potential for death as a result of contracting Coronavirus. **THE UNDERSIGNED AGREES THAT IT KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUMES ALL SUCH RISKS, BOTH KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERS, AND ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE CAMPER'S PRESENCE AT AND PARTICIPATION IN ANY ACTIVITY AT THE FACILITIES. THE UNDERSIGNED**



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AGREES THAT IN THE EVENT THAT THE CAMPER CONTRACTS, TESTS POSITIVE FOR OR SHOW SYMPTOMS OF HAVING CONTRACTED COVID 19 OR ANOTHER COMMUNICABLE DISEASE, HHH CAN PROHIBIT THE CAMPER FROM PARTICIPATING IN ANY ACTIVITIES AND REQUIRE THAT THE CAMPER LEAVE THE PROPERTY.

(j) Binding nature: agree that this agreement ensures to the benefit of HHH and its successors and assigns and is binding upon the undersigned, any other parent or legal guardian of the Camper, the Camper and any of the undersigned and their respective heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns. Any provision of this Agreement which is invalid or unenforceable shall be ineffective to the extent of such invalidity or unenforceability without invalidating or rendering unenforceable the remaining provisions hereof. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario and federal laws of Canada applicable therein.

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CELL PHONE POLICY

Haliburton Hockey Haven Sports Camp has a STRICT NO CELL PHONE/DEVICE/ELECTRONICS policy (including laptops, tablets, other computers, electronic games and other devices) for the enjoyment of camp by all campers **and to ensure all campers are abiding by the same rules.**

If a camper is found with or using any sort of cell phone or electronic device while attending camp, Haliburton Hockey Haven Sports Camp has the right to confiscate the phone. In addition to confiscating the phone, if a cell phone or electronic device is found in a camper's possession at any time while attending camp, Haliburton Hockey Haven Sports Camp may send the camper home for the remainder of the week without a refund. All campers have the option to leave their cell phones or electronic devices with their parents at check-in or with the directors for safe storage and return at the end of their camp week.

For campers staying multiple weeks, those campers will be able to leave their phone with the directors upon arrival at camp for storage and safe keeping and on Saturday (after general camper check-out and departure), they will be able to use their cell phone/electronic device for parent contact, which will then be returned to the directors for safe storage prior to Sunday check-in of the upcoming week's campers.

By signing below you acknowledge having read and agreed to the above no cell phone policy and acknowledge that if your camper is found with a cell phone/smart phone/electronic device they are subject to dismissal from camp for the remainder of the week without refund. By signing below, you acknowledge that you will not be sending your camper to Haliburton Hockey Haven Sports Camp with a cell phone, or alternatively will ensure your camper turns their phone in to the directors at check in for safekeeping for the week at camp.

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Sun Exposure and Safety Policy and Procedures

Policy Statement

Due to the nature of the activities and programs designed by Haliburton Hockey Haven Sports Camp (HHSC), sun exposure is unavoidable. It is the policy of HHSC that staff will take reasonable measures to protect program participants and themselves against harm from the sun.

Purpose

To assist in providing a sun-safe environment for HHSC program participants and staff.

Procedures for Residential and Day Campers, and HHSC Staff

HHSC will provide parents and guardians with information along with registration materials regarding sun-safety and exposure, as well as the items needed to comply (sun screen, suitable clothing, etc.). This is in hopes that parents will adhere to the policy and prepare their child as necessary. Included with the registration materials will be recommendations that sun screen be applied prior to drop off (both day and residential campers), and that a sunscreen suitable for the camper is packed in their bags. Due to a high number of varying skin sensitivities and allergies, HHSC will not provide campers with sunscreen.

HHSC staff will encourage other staff and campers to wear sunglasses and a hat at all times while outside. In instances where wearing a t-shirt would impede staff from performing duties, such as swim instruction, other methods of protection from the sun will be employed. Cabin Leaders will supervise and remind campers to apply sunscreen and wear appropriate clothing every morning, and throughout the day to ensure reapplication is occurring. If a staff is to assist in application of sunscreen, it will be done in a public, open area, with two or more staff members present. HHSC staff will also ensure there is adequate shade available and notify a supervisor if they notice a child is showing signs of adverse effects of sun exposure, and will contact the parents when appropriate.

Parents will be provided with a form acknowledging awareness of the sun-safety policy, with an additional option of a release form to request assistance from HHSC staff to assist with application (or re-application) of sunscreen. HHSC staff will be provided with a list of those campers who have requested assistance with sunscreen application.

Parents will be contacted by phone if a camper refuses to follow sun safety procedures.

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THINGS YOU SHOULD BRING WITH YOU IN YOUR BACKPACK or DUFFEL BAG

Note: Please no hard suitcases for storage purposes

-  Sleeping Bag or your own bedding: comforter or blanket & sheets
-  Pillow and Pillow Case
-  Personal Toiletry Kit including: toothpaste/brush, soap, shampoo, hand towel, face cloth, hairbrush, feminine hygiene products
-  Sunscreen SPF 30 or higher (waterproof recommended) HHH does not and cannot provide sunscreen. Every camper must bring their own.
-  Bug repellent with DEET – concentration no greater than 10% for youth and 30% for adults
-  Prescription medication (forms filled out and emailed to health@camphockeyhaven.com)
-  Two towels (one for beach and one for shower)
-  Swimwear (appropriate for water sports & active camp activities)
-  Socks (include a warm pair, for example: wool)
-  Underwear!
-  2 Pair of pants (light and loose)
-  5 Pair of shorts
-  2 Pair of footwear (one pair of running shoes or hiking boots for active wear and one pair of sandals or water shoes)
-  6 T-shirts (includes both short and long sleeve or light sweater)
-  Warm sweaters (hoodies) or sweatshirts – fleece is ideal
-  Rain wear (rain jacket and pants preferred)
-  Hat (bucket, baseball etc.) Bug hat – if you have one
-  Personal items: cards, books, writing paper, flashlight (check batteries)



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VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- 🏆 Please remember to notify HHH Camp staff of all medical information and dietary concerns at check-in
- 🏆 Please do **NOT** bring any food or snack products to camp. HHH is a NUT CONTROLLED FACILITY. Any food brought to camp will be confiscated and disposed of in a proper manner.
- 🏆 HHH has a **STRICT NO CELL PHONE/DEVICE/ELECTRONICS** policy (including laptops, tablets, other computers, electronic games etc). These items are not permitted so that Campers can experience camp the way we believe it should be experienced
- 🏆 HHH is not responsible for any lost or stolen items – Please leave all valuables, electronic devices, keepsakes and Jewelry at home
